General information

1. Registration

- All registration and payments must be made using the on-line registration system. Students register themselves or Instructors can do it on their behalf. Information for the event will be contained on the registration web site.
- **To register**, go to the CTFI Web Site www.ctfi.org. The main page will have a link to register, or you can click on “Upcoming Events”, find the listing for the Eastern Championships, then click on “Register to compete”.
- **Registration Deadline: All registrations and payments must be received before February 22, 2012.**

Competitor Fees :

- 60\$** Color belt for one or two events
- 75\$** Black Belt for one or two events
- 50\$** for team pattern
- 30\$** for pre-arranged sparring

3. Rules and divisions

- The ITF competition rules are applied in this championship.
- This championship is sanctioned by the Canadian Taekwon-Do Federation International and will follow the rules of the International Taekwon-Do Federation.

- Judges, Officials and Trainers meeting will begin Saturday at 8:00 a.m. During the meeting, the trainers will receive the drawing results for the judging of the competition. The competition will begin at 9:00 a.m.
- **Black Belt Card:** Upon arrival at the event, all participants will be required to check-in at the registration desk either at the Days Inn Hotel hotel on March 23/12 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm, or at the venue on the morning of March 24/12. All Black Belts must show their ITF Black Belt registration card at check-in.
- **Black Belt Weight check:** There will be competitor weight checks will be on Friday evening March 23/12 at the Days Inn Hotel from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday morning March 24/12 at the Tournament Venue between 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

All Black Belts (all ages) must have their weight category verified at the weigh-ins. Pre-Junior Black Belts (age 13 and under) and Super Senior (age 35+) must be within +/- 3kg of their stated weight or they will be disqualified. Junior and Senior Black Belts (age 14-35) must fall within their selected weight divisions or they will be disqualified.

- In this competition, each competitor must wear the official ITF dobok.
- Approved free sparring safety equipment is MANDATORY and must be provided by competitors. This includes the following:
 - Hand, foot and HEAD protectors as specified in the CTFI rules of competition. All ages and all ranks must wear helmets. Check with your instructor to be certain if your equipment qualifies.
 - Mouth guards.
 - Groin cup for all males.

Optional safety equipment that will be allowed is as follows:

- Foam shin guards
- Chest protectors and/or groin protectors for females

Note: Black Belts competing in the Junior and Senior divisions must have hand, foot and head protectors approved by ITF for international competition. This is specifically Top Ten, Fujimae, Top Pro and Granmark brands. Black Belts will be required to wear either red or blue depending on their position in the draws. Black Belts must have sets of both colours

Coloured Belts, Pre-Junior Black Belt (Age 13 and under) and Super Senior Black Belts (age 35+) may wear ITF approved gear or the standard foam safety gear such as Macho or Century. Any colour is allowed for this group, but we recommend red or blue (if you have it) to help the umpires.

- Four medals will be delivered in each division: gold, silver and two bronzes.
- Division merging may occur if the number of competitor in a division is less than 4, except for junior and senior black belt categories.
- Umpires and officials must wear official ITF referee attire: blue pants (no jeans), white shirt, blue tie and white shoes.

4. Insurance

The Organizing Committee and CTFI are not responsible for any injuries. Participants must have full insurance cover for any injuries. Instructors must provide Proof of Insurance by March 3, 2012, or their competitors will be allowed to participate.
